

## Publication Ethics and Publication Malpractice Statement

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The *HJH&SW* Editorial Board is comprised of the Editor (or Co-Editors), Associate and Assistant Editors, Copy Editors, and Contributing Editors. The Editorial Board evaluates submissions on the basis of their academic merit (importance, originality, study's validity, clarity) and its relevance to the journal's scope, without regard to the authors' race, gender, sexual orientation, ethnic origin, citizenship, religious beliefs, political philosophies or institutional affiliations. The Editorial Board is responsible for deciding which submissions to the journal will be published. In the event of a disagreement the Editor has the ultimate decision-making authority. The *HJH&SW* Editorial Board meets monthly.

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Editors and staff members should only disclose information about a submitted manuscript to the corresponding author, reviewers, potential reviewers, other Editorial Board members, and the publisher as appropriate.

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
